League Constitution (2014)

- The League shall be called "The Norfolk Bowls Association League", being a constituent part of Norfolk Bowls Association, subject to any changes to title as a result of a sponsorship deal.
- 2) Any alteration or change that materially affects the structure of the League and its zones shall be made only at the Annual Meeting or at a Special General Meeting and at such meeting such alteration or change shall be put to the vote by (a) the appointed representatives of the clubs and (b) members of the League Management Committee. Any alteration or change shall require a 67% vote in favour.
- 3) Teams comprising each zone or any agreed alternative, to be decided by the League Management Committee who reserves the right to make any adjustments as may be deemed necessary from time to time.
- 4) The affairs of the Norfolk Bowls Association League shall be conducted by the Men's County President, Men's Hon County Secretary, and Men's Hon League Secretary, who shall be elected by the Norfolk Bowls Association, together with a Vice-President, Chairman, Vice-Chairman, and one Representative from each zone of the league, who shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting of the Norfolk Bowls Association League.
- 5) The League Management Committee shall consist of the President, Vice-President, Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Hon Secretary, Hon County Secretary, and one elected representative from each zone of the league. Five members will form a quorum. Any Committee Meetings to be called at the discretion of the Secretary.
- 6) Membership of the league shall be open to all clubs affiliated to the Norfolk Bowls Association.
- 7) Entry fees to be determined annually by the Norfolk Bowls Association. All entries must be made & entry fees paid to the County Competition Secretary not later than 1st November.
- 8) Alteration of or additions to, all or any of the foregoing rules, shall be made only at the Annual Meeting or at a Special General Meeting convened for the purpose and four weeks' written notice of the terms of such proposed alteration or addition, which shall also be stated in the notice of business for such meeting, shall be given to the secretary. All such notices of motion must be submitted by clubs through their honorary secretaries, or by the League Management Committee through the League Secretary. Basic changes are subject to the acceptance by the Men's section of the Norfolk Bowls Association.
- 9) The Annual Meeting of the league shall be held on such a date as shall be fixed by the League Management Committee. Fourteen days' notice of it and of all General Meetings shall be given. Recommendations and notices of motion to the Annual General Meeting shall be submitted by the League Management Committee through the League Secretary, or the clubs through their Hon Secretaries. Every item, which appears on the agenda, shall be discussed and put to the vote. Members of all clubs may attend any General Meeting and take part in the business, but only their appointed representative, together with the members of the League Management Committee, have the power of voting.
- 10) At all meetings, the Chairman shall have the casting vote as well as a deliberate vote.

County League Rules

(Version 2.5 as updated DECEMBER 2024)

County League Rules

(version 2.4 – DECEMBER 2024)

Rules of Play

- 1) League matches are limited to playing members of clubs affiliated to the Norfolk Bowls Association.
- All Teams to consist of 12 players, subject to rule (8d) constituted by 3 fours comprising any number of male & female playing members
- Clubs with more than one team in the league shall designate their strongest side their 'A' team, their second strongest side their 'B' team and their third strongest their 'C' team.

4) PLAYER REGISTRATION & ELIGIBILITY

- a) Clubs with more than one team in the County League must register 12 players for their 'A' team. The registered players must be registered with the Hon. League Secretary prior to their first scheduled League match in the year the season starts. Clubs with only one team in the County League do not need to register their players.
- b) Any player not being one of the registered players may play for any other of that Clubs teams for any number of games.
- c) The registered players may only play for the team for which they have been registered (but subject to paragraphs (e) & (f) below).
- d) Any team found to have broken rule 4 (c) shall have <u>5</u> points deducted for each occasion they have defaulted. In addition, for each game in which this rule has been broken the offending team will lose any points won in that game and all points for that game will be awarded to the opposing team. In addition the offending team will have 10 shots added to their "shots against" total and the opposing team will have 10 shots added to their "shots for" total
- e) In exceptional circumstances, a member of the originally registered players may be deregistered from that team in order that he may play for another of that Club's team. An approach must be made to the Hon. League Secretary in writing or by e-mail giving the reason for the request to have that player de-registered. The decision on de-registration will be made by the Hon. League Secretary whose decision will be final.
- f) A player may only play for one Club in the current season but in exceptional circumstances, a player may play for a different Club. An approach must be made to the Hon. League Secretary in writing or by e-mail giving the reason for the request. The decision on whether the player may play for another club will be made by the Hon. League Secretary whose decision will be final.

5) COUNTY COMPETITIONS

A player may enter County Competitions from any club of which he is a bona fide playing member and is not restricted to entering from the Club to which he is registered for County League matches.

6) POINTS AWARDED

Subject to rules 4(d) & 7(f), in all league matches 2 points will be awarded to the winning team and 1 point to each team for each winning four. In the event of a tied four, each team shall receive half a point. In the event of a team tie each shall receive 1 point. If two teams finish the season level on points, the winner will be determined by shots difference & should this be equal the winner will be ascertained by the aggregate results of the matches already played between the two teams.

7) FIXTURE ARRANGEMENT

- a) Fixtures will be notified to Club Secretaries by the League Secretary.
- b) (unless specified Matches will be played home and away otherwise) on fixed dates to be determined by the League Management Committee, but may be played on an alternative date by mutual agreement, provided all fixtures are completed prior to the last scheduled date of matches in the respective league zone
- c) Any club with two teams in the same league must play their games home and away against each other before the last three games of the season.
- d) No match may be postponed to a later date without the permission of the League Secretary, other than when a match is postponed because of weather conditions or two or more players are involved in International Matches or National Championships under the jurisdiction of the County Association or Bowls England. In these circumstances the League Secretary <u>must</u> be informed of the postponement and the match re-arranged in accordance with para (e) below
- e) In the event of a match being postponed in accordance with the above a re-arranged date for the match must be agreed within 7 days of the date of the original fixture date and the League Secretary informed of the re-arranged date. The home team shall, within four days of the original fixture date, offer their opponents a minimum of two dates but not more than four, subject to the limit dates above, one of which must be accepted.
- f) If a team fails to fulfil a match or postpones a match without the permission of the League Secretary per para (d) above their opponents will be awarded 5 points and have 10 shots added to their "shots for" total & the offending team will be deducted 5 points and have 10 shots added to their "shots against" total

8) PLAYING ARRANGEMENTS

- a) League Matches will commence not later than 6.30pm up to the end of July and at 6.15pm for all dates in August.
- b) All matches will consist of 18 live ends. No trial ends will be played, other than visiting teams playing on an artificial surface who shall have the option of two trial ends provided they are completed prior to the designated commencement time and will be deemed not to infringe law 15 of the laws of the game.
- c) A draw will be made for rinks.
- d) If at the commencement time, a full team of 12 players is not present then the commencement time will be delayed for 15 minutes.

Unless a minimum of nine players are ready to play within a period of 15 minutes from the designated commencement time, the match will be deemed to be unfulfilled in accordance with rule 7 and points and shots will be allocated also in accordance with rule 7.

However if less than nine players are ready to play within a period of 15 minutes from the designated commencement time and the reason is due to an accident or illness en-route no points will be deducted and the match re-arranged as per rule 8.

If at the commencement time, which includes any 15 minute delay, a complete team of 12 players is not present, those players present must be formed into rinks of 3 or 4 players and the match then started with the playing format for each rink being:-

Rinks with 4 players:

Play will be in the usual manner for fours play

Rinks with only 3 players

Lead – no bowls played No. 2 - 2 bowls No.3 – 2 bowls Skip – 2 bowls

The opposition to the rink with 3 players to play 2 bowls per player in each position in the usual manner, with the lead playing 2 bowls one after the other.

At conclusion of each end, the team winning the end (or having the jack on the 1st end) will cast the jack BUT the lead in the team with the 4 players will always play the first 2 bowls, one after the other. The No.2 of the team winning the previous end (or having the jack on the 1st end) will then play and then the remaining bowls will be played in the usual order.

- e) Should the player(s) absent at the commencement time, then arrive, those player(s) will, at the conclusion of an end, slot into the rinks with only 3 players, as determined by their Team Captain, in ANY position with the other players moving up or down in position as necessary.
- Rinks with 4 players cannot be changed and no players may change from the rink in which they started the match
- g) All matches to be played to a conclusion with the final scores standing and points allocated in the usual fashion in accordance with rule 6
- h) Discs of the same colour shall be used on the bowls of all players of a team in the league.

9) INCLEMENT WEATHER

In the event of inclement weather determining that no further play is possible, matches, in which the number of ends played is 36, will be deemed to have been completed and the scores will stand. In matches where the total number of ends is less than 36, the tie will be declared void and the game replayed. Play will cease on all rinks simultaneously and ends commenced but not completed shall be declared null and void.

10) PLAYING RULES

All matches to be played under Bowls England Rules, unless amended herein.

11) DRESS CODE

The dress code for all matches will be in accordance with Bowls England Regulations

12) LEAGUE PLAYOFFS

For all rounds of the WP Baker Cup & Hansells Solicitors Cup the Umpire present will, prior to the match commencing, nominate the rink number to play an extra end should this be required.

Play shall be in accordance with rule 6 but in the event of a tie on points the nominated rink number will play an extra end and the result of this end will determine the result. The zone play offs shall be on dates, other than the Middleton Cup semi-finals/final date, fixed by the League Management Committee.

13) RESULT SUBMISSION

For the purpose of acquainting the league secretary with the match result, a club representative will submit the match result within two days of the match via the template on the Norfolk Bowls Association website. The match score cards must be retained by the Club Secretary in case of dispute of the result or player eligibility

14) PRESENTATIONS

The following presentations will be made:

- a) The winners of the Premier Zone will hold the 'Cromer Cup' for one year & in addition their club will receive a bannerette and 14 medals.
- b) The winners of each Zone 1 will play off for the League Championship and hold the 'WP Baker Cup' for one year & in addition their club will receive a bannerette and 14 medals and the runners-up will receive the CPS Gas Cup.
- c) The winners of each Zone 2 and 3 will play off for the 'Hansells Solicitors League Cup' to be held for one year and in addition, the winning club will receive a bannerette, 14 medals and the sum of £100. The runner-up will receive the Hansells Cup and the sum of £75 and the losing semi-finalists £25. In the event of the league structure meaning there are less than four Zone 2 & Zone 3 winners, the League Management Committee will then decide on the teams to be involved in the play off.
- d) Shields will be presented to Zone 1, 2 and 3 winners with the exception of the WP Baker Cup winner.

15) PREMIER LEAGUE & PROMOTION/RELEGATION

a) The winner of the League Championship shall be invited to join the Premier Zone. Should that club decline, the runner-up shall be invited. b) The bottom team in the Premier zone shall be relegated to an appropriate Zone provided the winner or runner up of the League Championship wishes to join the Premier Zone.

The Premier shall consist of 8 teams.

Two teams will be promoted from Zones 2 and 3, and two teams relegated from Zones 1 and 2.

If, as a result of a team being promoted to the Premier Zone, a Zone 1 has 6 teams, then instead of two teams being relegated to Zone 2 only one team will be relegated, and likewise only one team relegated to Zone 3.

Where as a consequence of a new entry, a Zone 3 has 9 teams then only one team will be relegated from a Zone 2 provided the Zone 2 does not have 9 teams.

Where as a consequence of relegation from the Premier Zone a Zone 1 has 9 teams then 3 teams will be relegated to a Zone 2 and 2 teams promoted from a Zone 2.

In any circumstance where a Zone 2 will comprise 9 teams then 3 teams will be relegated to a Zone 3 and 2 teams promoted from a Zone 3.

- c) Where a club has more than one league team and the team promoted to the Premier Zone is other than an 'A' team, it will be re-designated as their 'A' team, subject to their 'A' team not already being in the Premier Zone, in which case the promoted team would be designated 'B'.
- d) Should a club with one team withdraw that team from the Premier Zone at the conclusion of the season, the bottom team shall be relegated and both the winner and runner-up of the League Championships invited to join the Premier Zone.

16) ALTERATION TO RULES

Alteration of or additions to all or any of the foregoing rules shall only be made at the Annual Meeting or at a Special General Meeting convened for the purpose. Four weeks written notice detailing the terms of such proposed alterations or addition, which shall also be stated in the notice of business for such meeting, shall be given to the Secretary. All such notices of motion must be submitted by clubs through their Honorary Secretaries or by the League Management Committee through the League Secretary.

17) FINANCIAL BUSINESS

All financial business shall be done through the Norfolk Bowls Association.

18) PROTESTS

For the purpose of considering and determining all disputes, complaints and protests there shall be established a special sub-committee consisting of the Hon. League Secretary, League Chairman, Hon. Men's County Secretary, Men's County President & one of the elected League Zone representatives.

All protests appertaining to the green etc. must be intimated before the commencement of the sixth end and all protests against a player within three days after the game.

Notwithstanding the intention to lodge a protest appertaining to the green the game must be completed. Protests appertaining to the green shall be notified on completion of the game and confirmed in writing to the Hon. League Secretary within one day of the game. The Secretary of the club concerned will be notified of an inspection by the greens inspection committee who will report to the sub-committee whose decision will be final and will be conveyed to the Secretaries of the Clubs concerned.

Notwithstanding the intention to lodge a protest against a player the game must be completed. Protests appertaining to a player shall be notified in writing to the Hon. League Secretary within three days of the game and will be referred to the sub-committee who will consider the protest and make a decision which will be final. The decision will be conveyed to Secretaries of the Clubs concerned.

NORFOLK BOWLS ASSOCIATION Men's Rules - DECEMBER 2021

Rule 1 - Administration

The male affairs of the Association shall be concluded by a Men's Annual Meeting, a Men's Management Committee, Groups and a Selection Committee as follows

- (a) Men's Annual Meeting
- (b) Men's Management Committee
- (c) Groups
- (d) Men's County and National team selection
- (e) Election Format

(a) Men's Annual Meeting

Those persons empowered to vote at the Men's Annual Meeting or Special General Meeting are

- (i) All members of the Men's Management Committee
- (ii) County Coach
- (iii) Group Competition Secretaries
- (iv) League Chairman
- (v) Norfolk Past Presidents and Associate Members Bowling Association Delegate
- (vi) Norfolk Vice Presidents Delegate
- (vii) Greens Maintenance Advisory Officer
- (viii) Greens Inspection Committee members
- (ix) Benevolent Fund Committee members
- Men's Past Presidents and Honorary Life Members of Norfolk County EBA Association and Norfolk Bowls Association
- (xi) Middleton Cup Manager
- (xii) Visiting Tourist Liaison Officer
- (xiii) County Tour Manager
- (xiv) EUBA (Eastern Area) Committee Representative
- (xv) Eastern Counties Co-ordinator
- (xvi) Safeguarding Officer

plus One delegate from each affiliated club except that clubs with a membership of between 100 and 200 may have 2 Delegates and clubs in excess of 200 members may have 3 Delegates. Any person shall only have one vote even should they hold more than one office within the County. The General Meeting may appoint from members such other Special Committees and Authorities as may be necessary to deal with special matters.

(b) Men's Management Committee

The Management Committee shall consist of the following Men's Officers –

- Chairman,
- President,
- Senior Vice President,
- Junior Vice President,
- the retiring President for a period of one year after his year of office, Secretary,
- Assistant Secretary,
- Treasurer,
- Match Secretary,
- Assistant Match Secretary,
- Competition Secretary,
- League Secretary,
- Bowls England Delegate,
- Delegate appointed by the NCIBA
- **and** four members nominated from the Group Meetings (one from each Group, who shall be called Group Representatives).

The Management Committee shall deal with all matters in connection with the proper conduct of the Men's game as part of the Association and such matters which may be delegated to it by the Executive Board or an Annual Meeting.

Five members shall form a quorum.

The Management Committee shall have the power to fill any vacancy arising among its Officers and members of Committees during the year. The Men's President, Senior Vice President and Secretary will in an emergency take over the running of a vacated position on the Management Committee until such time as a full meeting of the Management Committee is convened to fill the position. The Men's Management Committee will meet in January, April, July, September, and October of each year and at any other time when called for specific purpose.

The Committee will receive and discuss proposals for any Amendment to the, Men's Rules or Regulations of Norfolk Bowls Association, at the Men's Annual Meeting and any amendment to the Constitution of Norfolk Bowls Association at an Executive Board Meeting.

(c) Groups

A Group shall consist of Member Clubs comprising the County Competition Group for the previous year.

Group Representatives will have the responsibility to convene at least one meeting of member clubs annually. One meeting must take place prior to October 1^{st} to nominate the Representative to serve on the Management Committee who will be advised to the Men's County Secretary by 1^{st} October for confirmation at the Men's Annual Meeting.

Groups will deal with any other matters which may be appropriate and a report of each meeting will be given to the Men's County Secretary.

The Men's County Competition Secretary will arrange for a Competition Secretary to represent each Group but this office does not require ratification by the Men's General Meeting.

(d) Men's County and National team selection

(i) Presidents Invitation matches.

The teams will be selected by the President and the Match Secretary from nominations received on the official form provided.

(ii) County Friendly and Tourists Matches.

The Selection Committee shall consist of the Honorary Match Secretary & the Honorary Assistant Match Secretary with the assistance of the President. Teams will be selected from nominations received on the official forms provided. The selection committee shall have the power to invite suitable players not so nominated.

(iii) National Team Selection.

A Team Manager will be appointed by the Men's Management Committee for a period of 3 years. He will be responsible for the selection of the Middleton Cup, Eastern Counties League, Balcomb Trophy & White Rose Trophy Teams and any other events as may be instructed by the Men's Management Committee

- a) He will appoint a Captain for each team.
- b) He will appoint four assistants, one from each Group with whom he should meet regularly.
- c) The Manager shall have no restrictions to playing in any of these teams or events but the assistants shall not be eligible.
- d) The Team Managers shall maintain relevant records and information regarding achievements of teams and players with a copy of such information being deposited with the Hon. County Secretary.
- e) The County Match Secretary or such other Officers delegated for the time being shall be responsible for all general administration and for supplying information to the President and the Press Officer.
- f) At the conclusion of each season the Managers shall submit a written report to the Men's Management Committee.

(e) Election Format.

All nominations for the Management Committee, Junior Vice President, Middleton Cup Manager, Visiting Tourist Liaison Officer, County Tour Manager, Benevolent Committee Members, Greens Maintenance Advisory Officer, Greens Inspection Committee, Eastern Counties Co-ordinator, Honorary Life members and Safeguarding Officer

will be advised by club secretaries in writing to the Men's Honorary Secretary by15th September for consideration by the Management Committee, excluding Bowls England Delegate who shall be appointed by the Management Committee. If no nominations are received for an office then recommendations to the post will be submitted for election at the Men's General Meeting.

(i) All other Officers namely

League Chairman, Norfolk Vice Presidents Association Delegate, Group Representatives to serve on the Management Committee, and Norfolk Past President and Associated Members Bowling Association Delegate will be elected by their respective organisations and advised to the Men's County Secretary by October 1st.

These nominations will be advised to the Management Committee and the Annual Meeting but not voted upon.

 (ii) NCIBA Executive – automatic appointment of Men's County Secretary.

NCIBA Council automatic appointment of Men's County Secretary and Assistant Secretary.

ECBA – automatic appointment of President, Senior Vice President and Men's County Secretary.

Rule 2 - Men's Annual Meeting

The men's Annual Meeting shall be held on or before the second Sunday in December in each year. Twenty eight days' notice of it and of all General Meetings shall be given and 15 members shall form a quorum.

Recommendations and Notices of Motion to the Annual Meeting shall be submitted to the Men's County Secretary by 15th October. Later submissions will not be accepted for the Agenda but may be discussed at the discretion of the Chairman under Any Other Business without a decision being made.

Every item that appears on the Agenda will be discussed and put to the vote.

If the Management Committee shall determine that sufficient cause has been shown a Special General Meeting must be summonsed on the requisition of an affiliated club to consider the business or grievance set forth in the requisition. The requisition must state clearly the nature of the matter at issue and be signed by the Honorary Secretary of the club. The Notice calling such a Special General Meeting shall state the purpose for which it has been summonsed and no other business shall be transacted at the meeting. Members of all clubs may attend any Annual Meeting and take part in the business but only those designated in Rule 1(a) (i) may vote.

Rule 3 - The Management Committee in Appeal

The Management Committee shall be empowered to adjudicate upon any disputes referred to it arising between or amongst Affiliated Clubs or any members thereof as to the meaning or interpretation of the laws of the game or any of the rules, byelaws, regulations and conditions or any point not covered by the laws, rules, bye-laws regulations or conditions or any matter of practice policy or complaint which it shall hold to be within its jurisdiction. The subject of reference or appeal must be stated in writing to the Men's County Secretary who shall call either a Special Management Meeting to discuss it or postpone its consideration until the next Management Meeting. Parties may be heard on each side and the decision of the Management Committee shall be final.

Rule 4 - Alterations to Rules and Regulation

The Norfolk Bowls Association Men's Rules may be amended, rescinded, added to, at the Men's Annual Meeting or any Special General Meeting convened for that purpose.

Notices of Motion should be given to the Men's County Secretary by October 15th for discussion at the Annual Meeting. At any other time, upon a receipt of Notice of Motion the Men's Secretary will discuss the subject matter with the Management Committee and if advised by them will give 28 days notice of a Special General Meeting to members. No such proposal for alteration of or addition to the foregoing rules shall be deemed to have been passed unless at least two thirds of the votes are cast in favour.

Any changes will be advised to the next Norfolk Bowls Association Executive Board meeting for ratification but will not be voted upon.

Competition Regulations

In the 2 Bowl Singles, 4 bowl Singles, Junior Singles, Pairs, Triples and Fours Championship no player may play for more than one club. A player may only play for one club in the Jermy Cup & Bales Cup or for one side in the Lord Fermoy Cup. This need not be the same club or the club from which he entered the individual County Championships.

The dates on which games are played are subject to byelaws 9, 14 & 15.

Junior Singles

- This Competition shall be open to male applicants who are full members of clubs affiliated to the Norfolk Bowls Association who have not attained the age of 25 on the 1st of April in the year of the competition.
- 2. Each game shall consist of 21 shots with four bowls each player. The first drawn player must provide a marker.
- 3. The early rounds of the competitions <u>may</u> be played on an area basis, which may not conform to the groups and sections of other competitions.
- 4. The player whose name appears first in a draw is designated the 'Challenger' & similarly the player whose name appears second is designated the 'Opponent'.

For ties prior to the quarter finals:-

The challenger shall offer his opponent the choice of 2 dates.

Ties at weekends shall not commence before 10.00am and ties on weekdays shall be arranged to commence at 6.30pm. Other times may be offered if agreed by both players/teams. These dates must be offered not less than 14 days before the closing date of the opening round of the Championship or within 5 days, after the closing date of the previous round

If the challenger does not offer dates within the required time period the opponent becomes the challenger and shall offer dates as above at their own club. When dates are offered, the arrangement must be confirmed within 72 hours and must adhere to any arrangements made

If the opponent has previously arranged to play another County Championship on one or both of the two dates offered or is on outdoor International duty or on Bowls England business, the Challenger is required to offer alternative dates

5. All ties from the Quarter Finals onwards will be played on fixed dates on greens selected by the Competition Secretary.

Two Bowl Singles Championship

- Each game shall consist of 21 ends with 2 bowls for each player. In the event of a tie, an
 extra end or ends shall be played until a decision has been reached. The first drawn player
 must provide a marker.
- 2. The early rounds of the competitions <u>may</u> be played on an area basis, which may not conform to the groups and sections of other competitions.
- Each round shall be played on the date stipulated, or in accordance with byelaw 9, 14 & 15.

Four Bowl Singles Championship

- 1. The winner shall be the first player to score 21 shots with 4 bowls for each player. The first drawn player must provide a marker.
- Each round shall be played on the date stipulated, or in accordance with byelaw 9, 14 & 15.

Pairs Championship

- 1. Each game shall consist of **18 ends** with 4 bowls for each player. In the event of a tie an extra end or ends shall be played until a decision has been reached.
- 2. Each pair shall consist of two men who must be bona fide playing members of the same club.
- 3. The two players taking part in the first game shall constitute the pair who should normally play together throughout the competition. One additional player, and the same player may, however, be used as a substitute at any time provided he has not already played in the competition, and may play in any position.
- Each round shall be played on the date stipulated or in accordance with byelaw 9, 14 & 15.

Triples Championship

- 1. Each game shall consist of **18 ends** with 3 bowls for each player. In the event of a tie an extra end or ends shall be played until a decision has been reached.
- Each triple shall consist of three men who must be bona fide playing members of the same club.

- 3. The three players taking part in the first game shall constitute the triple and should normally play together throughout the competition. One additional player, and the same player may, however, be used as a substitute at any time provided he has not already played in the competition, and may play in any position.
- Each round shall be played on the date stipulated, or in accordance with byelaw 9, 14 & 15.

Fours Championship

- 1. Each game shall consist of **18 ends** with 2 bowls for each player. In the event of a tie an extra end or ends shall be played until a decision has been reached
- 2. Each four shall consist of four men who must be bona fide playing members of the same club.
- 3. The four players taking part in the first game shall constitute the four and should normally play together throughout the competition. One additional player, and the same player may, however, be used as a substitute at any time provided he has not already played in the competition, and may play in any position.
- Each round shall be played on the dates stipulated or in accordance with byelaw 9, 14 & 15.

Junior Pairs Championship

- This Competition shall be open to male applicants who are full members who are full members of clubs affiliated to the Norfolk Bowls Association who have not attained the age of 25 on the 1st of April in the year of the competition. The two players may be from different clubs, but they must both be members of Clubs affiliated to Norfolk Bowls Association and have entered all other National Championship events from the same county.
- 2. Each game shall consist of **18 ends** with four bowls each player with the leads to playing their four bowls before the skips.
- In the event of the scores being equal when all ends have been played, an extra end or ends must be played until a decision is reached.
- 4. The early rounds of the competitions <u>may</u> be played on an area basis, which may not conform to the groups and sections of other competitions.
- 5. The player whose name appears first in a draw is designated the 'Challenger' on behalf of themselves and, where appropriate their team, similarly the player whose name appears second is designated the 'Opponent'.

For ties prior to the quarter finals:-The challenger shall offer his opponent the choice of 2 dates Ties at weekends shall not commence before 10.00am and ties on weekdays shall be arranged to commence at 7.00pm. Other times may be offered if agreed by both players/teams. These dates must be offered not less than 14 days before the closing date of the opening round of the Championship or within 5 days after the closing date of the previous round

If the challenger does not offer dates within the required time period the opponent becomes the challenger and shall offer dates as above at their own club. When dates are offered, the arrangement must be confirmed within 72 hours and must adhere to any arrangements made

If the opponent has previously arranged to play another County Championship on one or both of the two dates offered or is on outdoor International duty or on Bowls England business, the Challenger is required to offer alternative dates

6. All ties from the Quarter Finals onwards will be played on a dates determined by the Competition Secretary & on greens selected by the Competition Secretary.

Senior Fours Championship

- This Competition shall be open to male applicants who are full members of clubs affiliated to the Norfolk Bowls Association who have attained the age of 55 on the 1st of April in the year of the competition. All four players must come from the same club and must represent that same club from which all other National Championship events have been entered.
- 2. Each game shall consist of **18 ends** with 2 bowls for each player.
- 3. In the event of the scores being equal when all ends have been played, an extra end or ends must be played until a decision is reached.
- The early rounds of the competitions <u>may</u> be played on an area basis, which may not conform to the groups and sections of other competitions.
- 5. The player whose name appears first in a draw is designated the 'Challenger' on behalf of themselves and, where appropriate their team, similarly the player whose name appears second is designated the 'Opponent'.

For ties prior to the quarter finals: The challenger shall offer his opponent the choice of 2 dates

Ties at weekends shall not commence before 10.00am and ties on weekdays shall be arranged to commence at 6.30pm. Other times may be offered if agreed by both players/teams.

These dates must be offered not less than 14 days before the closing date of the opening round of the Championship or within 5 days after the closing date of the previous round. If the challenger does not offer dates within the required time period the opponent becomes the challenger and shall offer dates as above at their own club. When dates are offered, the arrangement must be confirmed within 72 hours and must adhere to any arrangements made

If the opponent has previously arranged to play another County Championship on one or both of the two dates offered or is on outdoor international duty or on Bowls England business, the Challenger is required to offer alternative dates

6. All games from the Quarter Finals onwards will be played on dates determined by the Competition Secretary & on greens selected by the Competition Secretary.

Club Championship Hansells (Bales Cup)

- 1. The competition is open to all clubs affiliated to the Norfolk Bowls Association.
- 2. Each club shall be represented by 12 male players (constituted by 3 fours) who must be bona fide playing members of the club.
- 3. The game shall consist of **18 ends** with 2 bowls for each player.
- 4. Prior to the game, the challenger will declare the 3 rinks on which the match will be played, of which one rink shall be drawn to play the extra end. The cards will then be placed face down, where a visiting club person will attach a rink number. The total number of shots over all rinks will decide the result. In the event of a draw an extra end will be played by the nominated rink immediately after all fours have completed 18 ends. Should this happen the result of the extra end will determine the result.
- Each round must be played on a date stipulated, or in accordance with byelaw 9, 14 & 15. The Quarter Finals, Semi-finals and the Final will be played on greens selected by the Competition Secretary.

Double Fours Championship (Lord Fermoy Cup)

- 1. A team shall be represented by 8 male players who must be bona fide playing members of the club.
- The game shall consist of 18 ends with 2 bowls for each player with one four to play at home and the other four away on the same day (but subject to byelaw 9)in all rounds except the final which will be played on a green selected by the Competition Secretary
- 3. In all rounds leading to the final, prior to the start of the match the club shown first in the draw shall nominate a rink to play an extra end which will be played by that rink immediately after the conclusion of its 18th end.

In the final, prior to the start of the game one rink shall be drawn to play an extra scoring end. In the event of a tied overall score, the drawn rink will play the extra end immediately after both fours have completed **18 ends** and the result of this extra end will determine the result.

- 4. A club is allowed to make any number of entries in this competition. Clubs shall have the option of substituting players and altering the position of players for the second or succeeding rounds, but a player may only play for one team in his club.
- 5. Each round must be played on the dates stipulated, or in accordance with byelaw 9, 14 & 15.

Jermy Cup

- 1. The competition shall be controlled by the Men's Competition Secretary of The Norfolk Bowls Association.
- 2. The competition shall be open to male and female members of clubs affiliated to the Norfolk Bowls Association on 1st MAY of the year of the and who must be bona fide playing members of that club. Clubs shall have the option of substituting players and of altering the position of players for the second or succeeding rounds. All players must be members of the same club.
- 3. The competition shall be played under the laws of the game adopted by the World Bowls Board and in accordance with the byelaws and regulations laid down by the Norfolk Bowls Association.
- 4. A club side shall consist of three rinks of THREE players with each rink comprising a minimum of one male and one female player & either gender may play as skip.
- Each club shall be represented by 9 players (constituted by 3 TRIPLES) who must be bona fide playing members of the club. The game shall consist of 18 ends with 3 bowls for each player
- 6. Prior to the game, the challenger will declare the 3 rinks on which the match will be played, of which one rink shall be drawn to play the extra end. The cards will then be placed face down, where a visiting club person will attach a rink number.
- 7. Total number of shots over all rinks will decide the result. In the event of a draw an extra end will be played by the nominated rink immediately after all TRIPLES have completed 18 ends. Should this happen the result of the extra end will determine the result.
- For the purpose of the competition, the County may be divided into Groups, Zones or Sections to be decided upon from time to time by the Competition Secretary according to entries received.
- 9. The Competition Secretary shall arrange all rounds of the Competition. The Semi-Finals and Final shall be played on a green selected by the Competition Secretary. There is nothing in the laws of the game, or in the rules of the competition, which stipulates that games may not be played on a surface other than grass. It is however a condition that the ties are played outdoors.
- 10. The Competition Secretary will send match details to the Secretary of the each club. The result must be telephoned immediately on completion of the game to the Competition Secretary. The result card properly completed clearly showing both teams and signed by both skips must be forwarded to the Competition Secretary.
- 11. All rounds shall be played on fixed dates notified by the Competition Secretary and games shall commence at 10am on the date fixed unless an alternative time is mutually agreed between competing clubs (apart from the semi-finals & finals which will be played on the date determined by the Competition Secretary). Games prior to the semi-final and final may however be played at an earlier date by mutual agreement with the exception of the fixed date for other competitions unless the participants are not in any other competition.

One trial end each way may be played at the start of the game with the appropriate number of bowls. No extensions will be allowed under any circumstances except for exceptional weather conditions as in competition byelaw 15.

- 12. In the event of no decision being reached owing to exceptional weather conditions the game shall be resumed within 7 days with the scores, as they were when the game was stopped. The first named side must contact their opponents within 24 hours to arrange a new date and notify the Competition Secretary. Under no circumstances, must a fixed date of another competition be used.
- 13. If a side fails to appear or not be ready to play within 30 minutes after the agreed time for the tie the opponents may claim a walkover.
- 14. For the purpose of considering and determining all disputes and protests there shall be a sub-committee comprising the Competition Secretary and two members of the Executive Committee as delegated. All protests appertaining to the green etc. must be intimated before the commencement of the sixth end and all protests against a player within 3 days of the game. The procedure is as explained in the Norfolk Bowls Association competition byelaws no. 17.
- 15. The Jermy Cup and a Pennant showing the year and name of the event will be presented to the winner at the Annual Luncheon or other event which might be arranged. The winner shall hold the trophy for one year and shall return it to the Competition Secretary by September 1st. The winner will be responsible for its safe custody other than insurance.


